

ORDINANCE TO REGULATE TRAFFIC SIGNS, SIGNALS,
MARKINGS AND REQUIRED STOPS OF THE TOWN OF
BROTHERTOWN, COUNTY OF CALUMET, WISCONSIN:

The Town Board of the Town of Brothertown, Calumet County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section¹. Provisions of State Law Adopted by Reference:

1. State Traffic Forfeiture Laws Adopted. Except as otherwise specifically provided in this ordinance, all provisions of Chapters 340.01, 346.37, 346.43, 346.44, 346.49, and Wisconsin Statutes Sections 345.20 to 345.53 describing and defining regulations with respect to traffic signs and required stops for vehicles for which the penalty is a forfeiture only, including penalties to be imposed and procedure for prosecution, are hereby adopted and by reference made a part of this ordinance as if fully set forth herein. Any act required to be performed or prohibited by any statute incorporated herein by reference is required or prohibited by this ordinance.

Section 2. Official Stop Signs and Traffic Controls and Through Highways Designated:

All town trunk highways in the Town of Brothertown, Calumet County, Wisconsin, shall hereafter be arteries for through traffic except that through traffic shall stop at the location of stop signs and stop signs shall be erected at the following locations:

Stop Signs Located on Town of Brothertown Roads at:

Stop sign going west on Jefferson Road approaching Lake shore Drive.

Stop sign on Driftwood Beach Road approaching Lakeshore Drive.

Stop sign on Lakeshore Drive approaching from north on Harbor Road.

Stop sign on Harbor Road approaching Lakeshore Drive from west.

Stop sign on Lakeshore Drive from south approaching Harbor Road.

Stop sign going west on Harbor Road approaching Lakeshore Drive.

Stop sign going west on Indian Road approaching Lakeshore Drive.

Stop sign going east on Gladwater Beach Road approaching Lakeshore Drive.

Stop sign on Banner Road going west approaching North Tower Road.

Stop sign on Indian Road going east approaching North Tower Road.

Stop sign on Dick Road going west approaching North Tower Road.

Stop sign on North Tower Road going north approaching West Jefferson Road.

Stop sign on North Tower Road going south approaching West Jefferson Road.

Stop sign on Lincoln going south approaching West Jefferson Road.

Stop sign on North Town Hall Road going south approaching West Jefferson Road.

Stop sign on North Town Hall Road going north approaching West Jefferson Road.
Stop sign on Stone Road going east approaching North Town Hall Road.
Stop sign on Dick Road going east approaching South Town Hall Road.
Stop sign on Banner Road going east approaching South Town Hall Road.
Stop sign on Paradise Road going north approaching St. Charles Road.
Stop sign on Paradise Road going south approaching St. Charles Road.
Stop sign on North Columbus Road going south approaching Paradise Road.
Stop sign on West Jefferson Road going east approaching North Columbus Road.
Stop sign on East Jefferson Road going west approaching North Columbus Road.
Stop sign on North Columbus Road going north approaching Harlow Road.
Stop sign on Paradise Road going north approaching East Jefferson Road.
Stop sign on North Washington Road going west approaching Paradise Road.
Stop sign on Paradise Road going west approaching North Columbus Road.
Stop sign on South Columbus Road going north approaching Paradise Road.
Stop sign on South Columbus Road going south approaching St. Charles Road.
Stop sign on Pioneer Road going east approaching South Columbus Road.
Stop sign on Weber Road going east approaching South Washington Road.
Stop sign on South Washington Road going north approaching St. Charles Road.
Stop sign on North Washington Road going south approaching St. Charles Road.
Stop sign on Wingers Road going west approaching South Town Hall Road.
Stop sign from Schmitz going east approaching Schoenborn Road.
Stop sign on Wagner Road going west approaching South Town Hall Road.

Section 3. Erection of Official Traffic Signs and Signals:
As authorized by the Town Board the official traffic signs and signals shall be procured, erected, and maintained; such traffic signs and signals and markings which conform to the rules of the State of Wisconsin and Federal regulations thereto.

Section 4. Penalty:
The penalty for violation of any provision of this ordinance shall be a forfeiture as hereafter provided together with the costs of prosecution imposed as provided in Section 345.20 to 345.53 of the Wisconsin Revised Statutes.

Section 5. Enforcement:
This ordinance shall be enforced in accordance with the provisions

of Sections 345.20 to 345.53, Chapter 299 and Section 66.12 of the Wisconsin Revised Statutes.

Section 6. References to Statutes:

References to specific statutory sections wherever used in this ordinance shall mean the Wisconsin Revised Statutes of 1971.

Section 7. Severability:

The provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town Board would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid and if any provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be effected thereby.

Section 8. Effective Date:

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and posting.

The foregoing ORDINANCE was adopted at a regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Brothertown, on the 5 day of March, 1975.
