

ORDINANCE 98-1

TOWN OF BROTHERTOWN CALUMET COUNTY, WISCONSIN

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE OVERNIGHT PARKING

WHEREAS, the Town of Brothertown Town Board, in the interest of public health and safety, finds it necessary and appropriate to regulate parking within the Town at designated areas; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has the authority to adopt these regulations pursuant to Section 60.10, Wis. Stat., as a reasonable exercise of its police power provided thereby, and pursuant to Sections 349.065 and 349.13, Wis. Stat.;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Brothertown, Calumet County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. RESTRICTIONS ON PARKING. There are hereby created areas within the Town of Brothertown designated as a "NO PARKING" area for purposes of overnight parking between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 3:00 a.m. During said hours, subject to the exceptions set forth in Section 346.50, Wis. Stat., no person shall park, stop or leave standing any vehicle, whether attended or unattended, between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 3:00 a.m. upon highways designated by the Town of Brothertown Town Board.

SECTION 2. DESIGNATED AREAS. The following areas are designated to be within the terms of Section 1:

2.1 The east and the west sides of Harbor Road from Brothertown Beach to the south end of Harbor Road.

2.2 All other areas as designated from time to time by adoption of a resolution by the Town Board.

SECTION 3. PENALTY. Any person violating this ordinance may be required to forfeit not less than \$20 nor more than \$40 for the first offense and not less than \$50 nor more than \$100 for the second or subsequent conviction within a year.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. The provisions of this ordinance are severable. In the event any portion of this ordinance is determined to be unconstitutional, invalid, or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such determination shall not affect the remainder of this ordinance. The Town Board hereby declares its intent to have passed all other provisions of this ordinance and the remainder of the ordinance shall not be affected by such determination.

SECTION 5. TRAFFIC SIGNS. The Town Board shall arrange for the erection of signs according to all applicable ordinances, statutes, motor vehicle code, and Uniform Traffic Manual to fulfill the requirements of this ordinance and any further resolution adopted pursuant hereto.
