

ORDINANCE NO. 2000- 3

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR INSPECTORS FOR POLLING PLACES

Whereas, Section 7.30 Wis. Stat. authorizes the Town Board to provide for additional methods of selection of workers at polling places; and,

Whereas, the Town of Brothertown deems the adoption of this Ordinance is in the public interest and will facilitate the servicing of the elections;

The Town Board of the Town of Brothertown do ordain, as follows:

SECTION 1. SELECTION OF ALTERNATE ELECTION OFFICIALS.

The Town Chairperson is authorized to nominate and appoint qualified persons to serve as alternate election officials and shall designate each person as an alternate election official as necessary.

SECTION 2. SELECTION OF TWO SETS OF OFFICIALS.

The Town Board authorizes the selection of two sets of officials to work at different times on election day, each set of officials to be selected and appointed by the Town Chairperson pursuant to the applicable Wisconsin Statutes and other Town of Brothertown Ordinances. The Town Chairperson is authorized to determine for each election whether to put into effect two sets of officials to work at different times on that election day. Unless the Town Chairperson so decides, one set of officials to work shall be used for each election.
