ORDINANCE NO. 2004- /

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE PLAN COMMISSION

The Town Board of the Town of Brothertown, Calumet County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Title. This ordinance is entitled the "Town of Brothertown Plan Commission Ordinance".

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to establish a Town of Brothertown Plan Commission and set forth its organization, powers and duties, to further the health, safety, welfare and wise use of resources for the benefit of future and current residents of the Town, through the adoption and implementation of Smart Growth Comprehensive Planning pursuant to Section 66.1001, Wis. Stat.

Section 3. Authority-Establishment. The Town Board, having been authorized under Section 60.10(2)(c), Wis. Stat., to exercise village powers, hereby exercises those powers under Section 60.22(3), Wis. Stat., and establishes a Plan Commission under Sections 61.35 and 62.23, Wis. Stat.

Section 4. Membership. The Plan Commission shall consist of seven members. At least three of the members shall be citizen members, not otherwise town officials.

Section 5. Appointments. The Town Chairperson shall appoint the Plan Commission members. The Chairperson shall also appoint a Plan Commission Chairperson. Such appointments shall be made at a Town Board meeting.

Section 6. Officers. There shall be a Chairperson, Vice Chairperson, and Secretary. The Vice Chairperson and Secretary shall be elected by the Plan Commission members from among the members.

Section 7. Terms of Office. The term of office for each Plan Commission member shall be three years, ending on April 30.

Section 8. Vacancies. A vacancy on the Plan Commission shall be filled by appointment by the Town Chairperson. A person appointed to fill a vacancy on the Plan Commission shall serve for the remainder of the term.

Section 9. Powers. The Plan Commission shall have all the powers granted under Section 62.23, Wis. Stat.

Section 10. Severability. The terms of this ordinance are severable. If any portion of this ordinance is found to be void or unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining portions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 11. Effective Date. Following passage by the Town Board, this ordinance shall take effect the day after the date of publication or posting as provided by Section 60.80, Wis. Stat.
