

**TOWN OF BROTHERTOWN
ORDINANCE GRANTING AUTHORITY TO TOWN CHAIRMAN
TO ISSUE PROVISIONAL RETAIL LIQUOR LICENSES**

The Town of Brothertown Board of Supervisors, having duly convened, does ordain as follows:

1. **PURPOSE.** The purpose of this Ordinance is the appointment of a Town official having authority to issue provisional liquor licenses pursuant to Wis. Stat., § 125.17(5) and § 125.185.

2. **AUTHORITY.** The Town Chairman shall have authority to issue provisional operator's licenses and provisional retail liquor licenses under §§ 125.17 and 125.185. Except as set forth in this Ordinance, the issuance of such licenses shall be at the sole discretion of the Town Chairman.


3. **REQUIREMENTS.** No provisional license may be issued unless the applicant has filed a completed application for the type of license which is sought to be issued provisionally, paid the application, publication and any other fees required for such application in full, and either holds a valid operator's license or is enrolled in a responsible beverage server training course meeting the qualifications of Wis. Stat., § 125.04(5)(a)5 and intends to obtain an operator's license after the successful completion of such course.
