RECOMMENDATION OF THE Town OF Brothertown PLAN  
COMMISSION TO ADOPT AMENDMENTS TO THE CALUMET COUNTY YEAR 2025  
SMART GROWTH PLAN AND THE Town of Brothertown  
EXPANDED LAND USE ELEMENT

WHEREAS, on February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2012, the Town of Brothertown adopted the Calumet County Year 2025 Smart Growth Plan and the Town of Brothertown Expanded Land Use Element in accordance with Section 66.1001, Wis. Stats.; and

WHEREAS, Section 66.1001 (2)(i), Wis. Stats. states that a comprehensive plan shall be updated no less than once every 10 years; and

WHEREAS, the Calumet County Planning, Zoning and Land Information Department conducted a 5-year update to coincide with the release of the 2010 U.S. Census; and

WHEREAS, the plan amendments include, but are not limited to: text, table, chart and map amendments to reflect available updated statistical and factual data, updates to land use and service matters, and identification of accomplishments achieved in the Implementation/Action section of the town's land use element; and

WHEREAS, the amendments satisfy the requirements of the State of Wisconsin Smart Growth Law and are consistent with, and support, the Public Participation requirements, and the nine required plan elements: Issues and Opportunities, Housing, Transportation, Agricultural, Natural and Cultural Resources, Economic Development, Land Use, Intergovernmental Coordination, and Implementation; and


WHEREAS, the Calumet County Planning, Zoning, and Farmland Preservation Committee held a public hearing on January 11, 2012, regarding amendments to the Calumet County Year 2025 Smart Growth Plan and the Town of Brothertown Expanded Land Use Element. The Committee reviewed and incorporated public comments into the plan.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Brothertown Plan Commission hereby recommends adoption of the amendments to Calumet County Year 2025 Smart Growth Plan and the Town of Brothertown Expanded Land Use Element to the Town Board of the Town of Brothertown.
